


## Health Indicators: Child Hospitalization by Mothers' Age

Hospitalization rates vary by the age of the mother when she had her first child, with children born to younger mothers having higher hospitalization rates. Children born to mothers who started childbearing when they were adolescents had particularly high rates. This was true even for older children: regardless of the age of the child, children born to mothers who had their first child as teens had higher hospitalization rates than children whose mothers were older when they began having children.


Inpatient Hospitalization Episode Rates for Children Aged 0-19 Years by Age of Mother at First Birth, 2000/01 - 01/02
