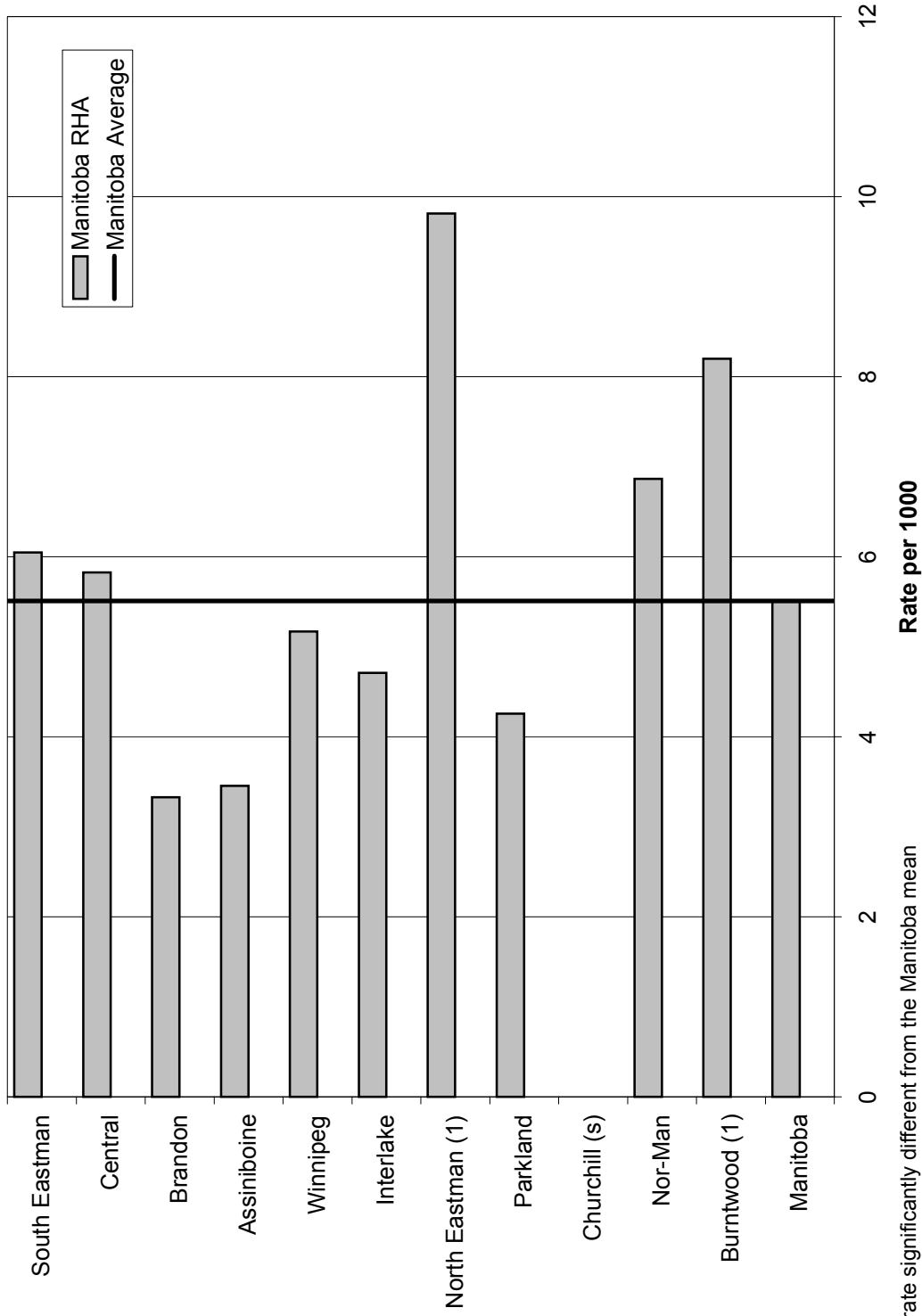

## Health Indicators: Infant Mortality

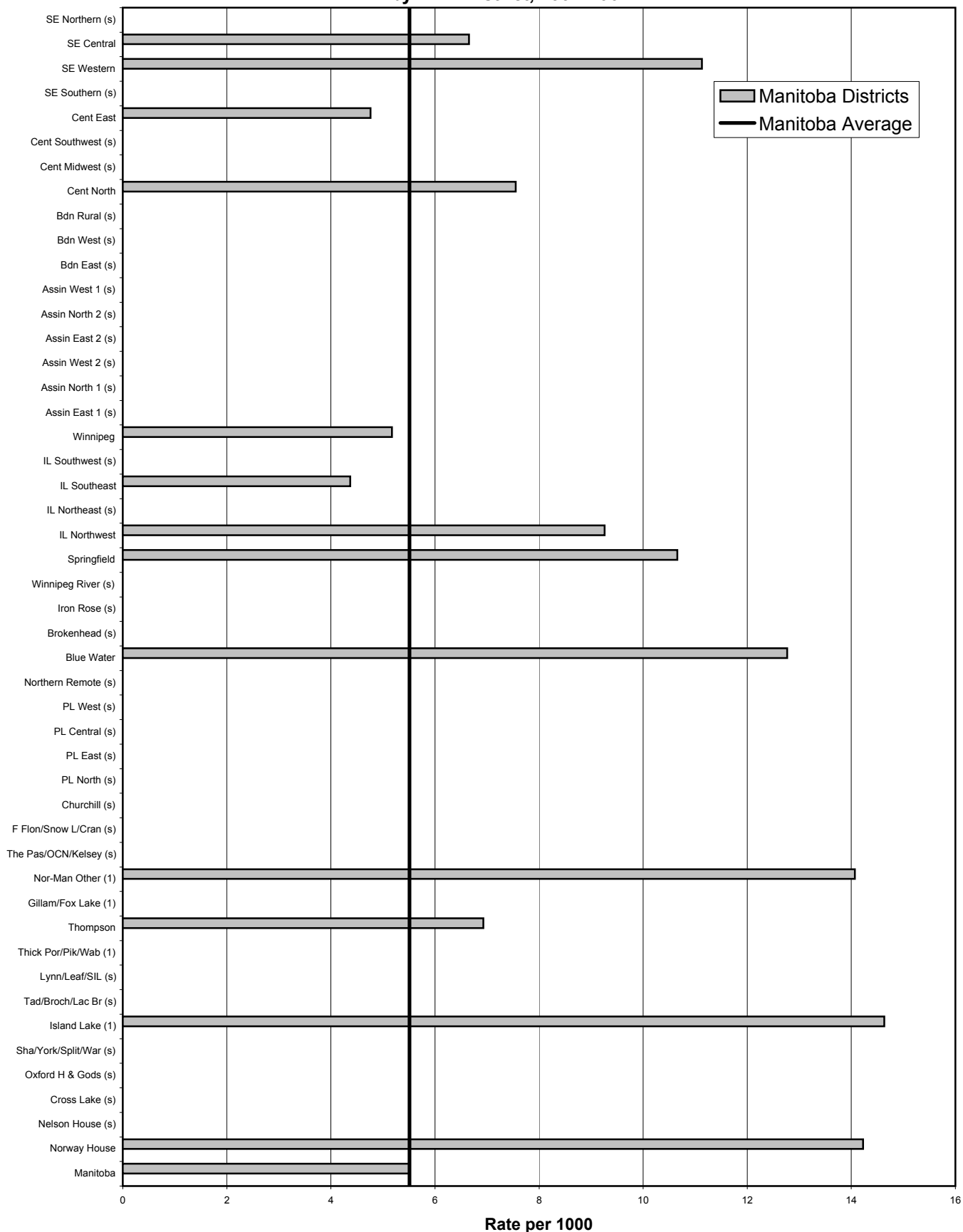
Infant mortality rates in this report include infants born in Manitoba and weighing 500 g or more at birth, or of 20 weeks or more gestational age. North Eastman and Burntwood RHAs have significantly higher infant mortality rates compared to the provincial average. RHA districts with significantly higher rates than the provincial average include Nor-Man Other and Island Lake. Infant mortality rates in Point Douglas (see Winnipeg CA graph) are significantly higher than both the Winnipeg and Manitoba average; at the Winnipeg NC level, infant mortality rates in Point Douglas South are significantly higher than the Winnipeg and the provincial average.

### Infant Mortality Rates for Liveborn Infants Under 1 Year of Age by RHA District, 1997-2001

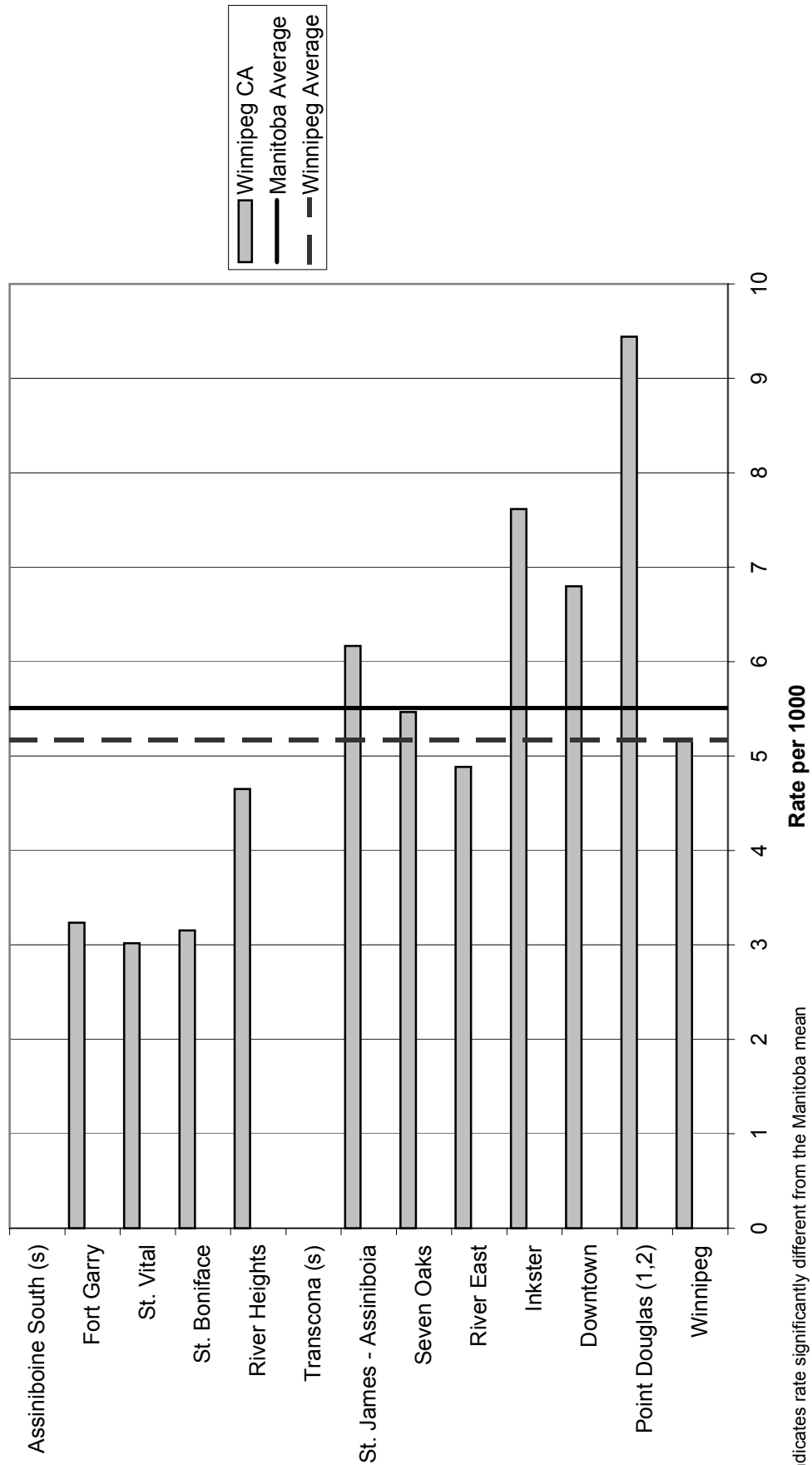


'1' indicates rate significantly different from the Manitoba mean

'2' indicates rate significantly different from the Winnipeg mean

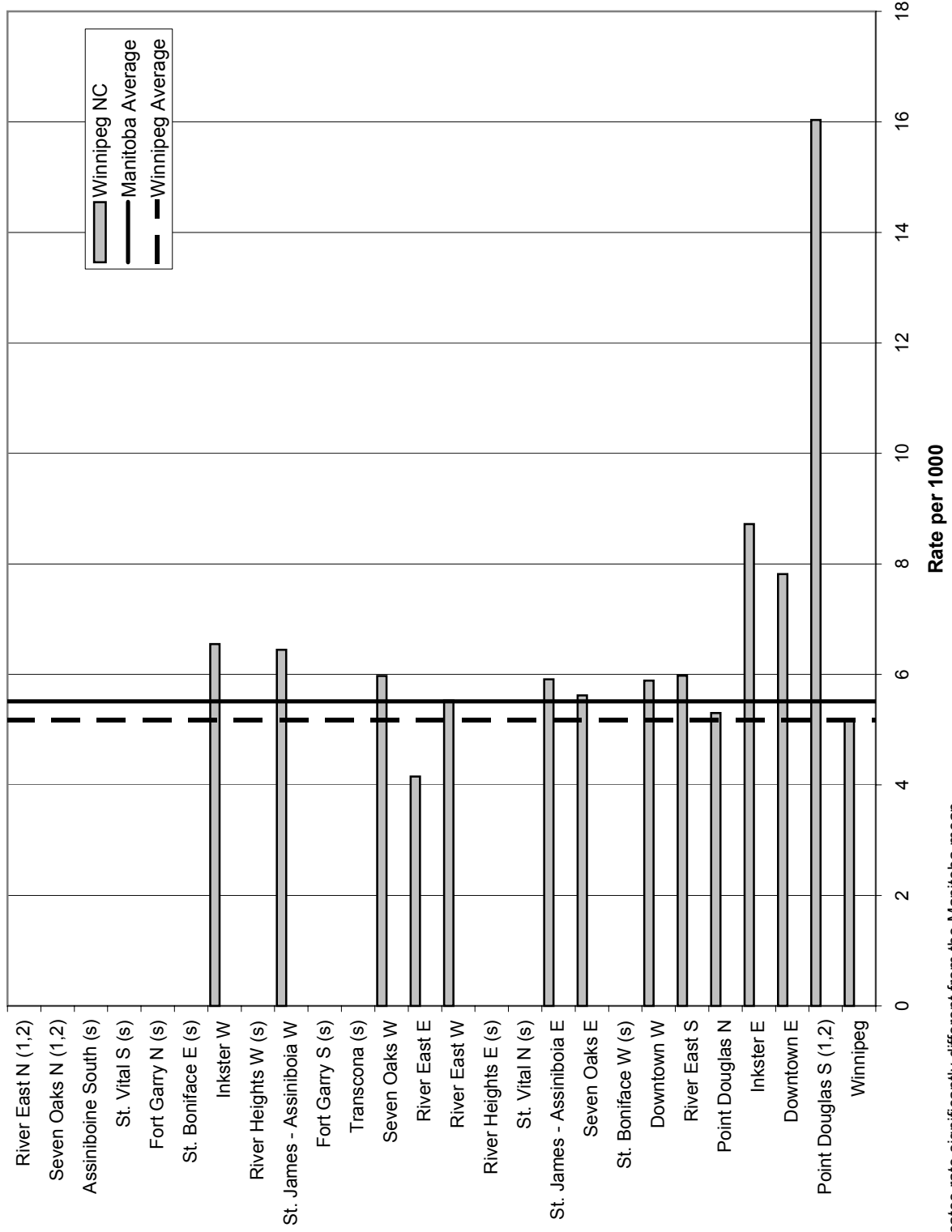
