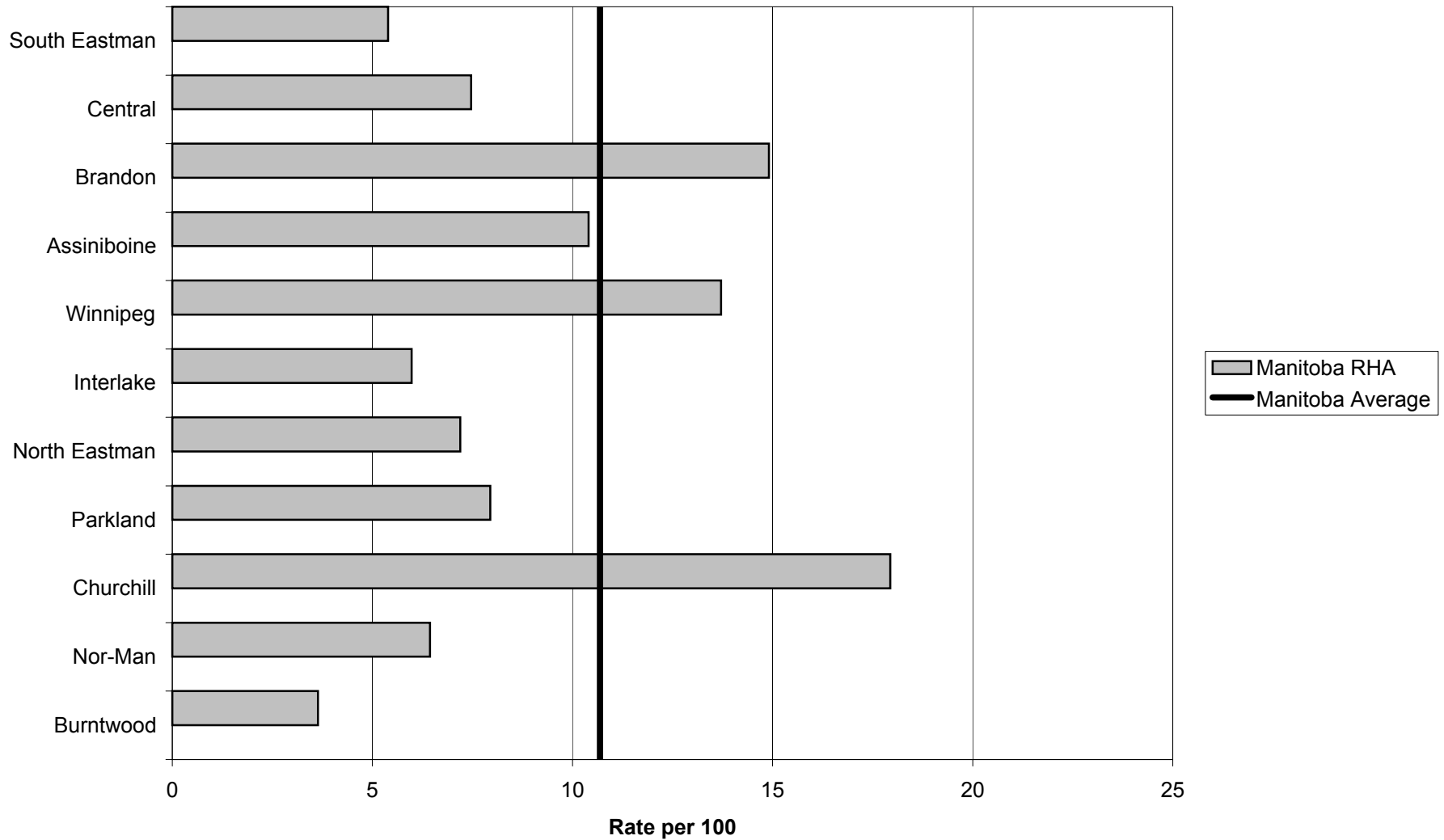

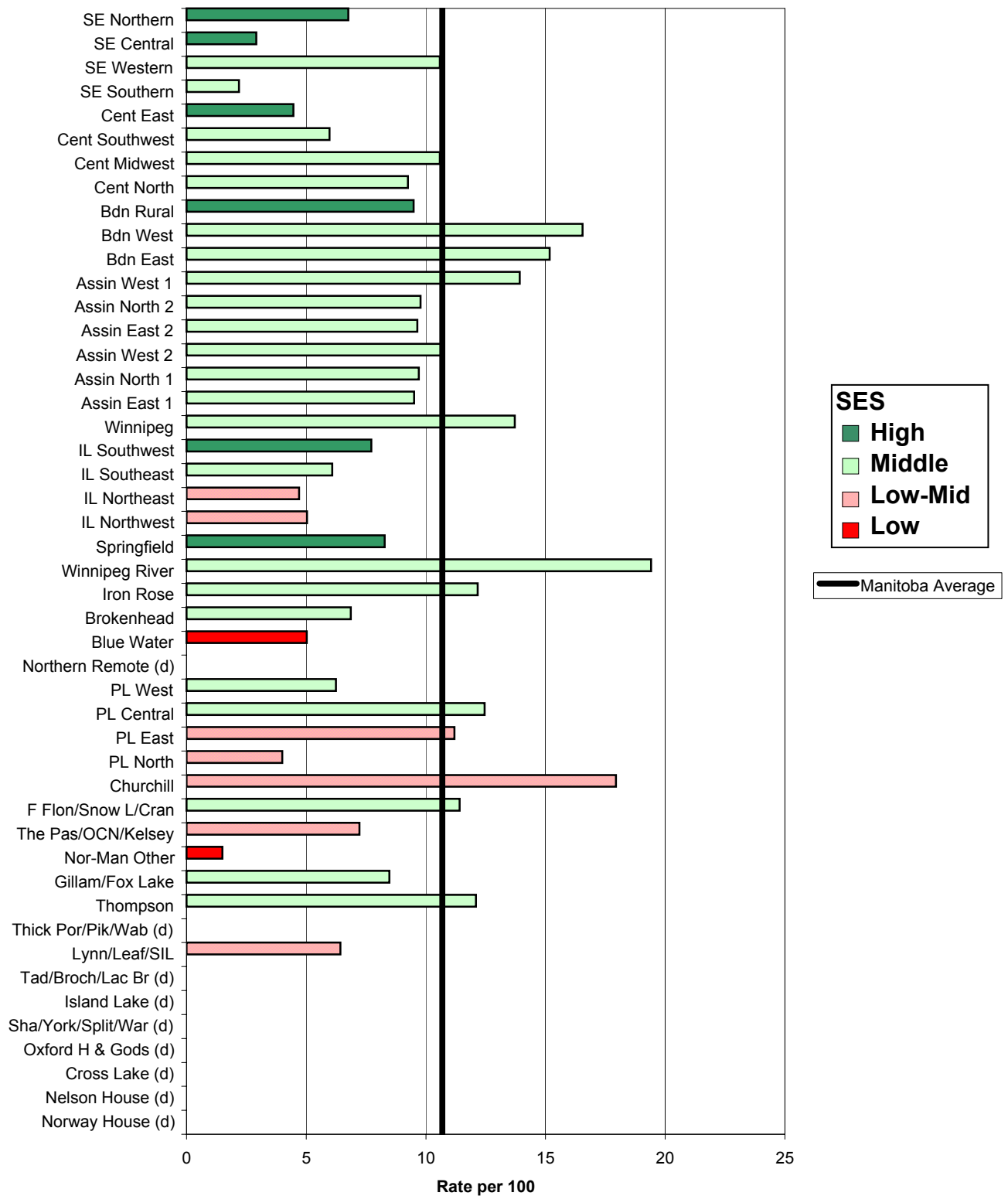
## Community Resource Indicators: Licensed Child Care Spaces by Region

The graphs presented here show rate of licensed child care spaces for children aged 0 to 12 years for Manitoba RHAs, RHA Districts, Winnipeg CAs and Winnipeg NCs. Note that the Winnipeg NC graph here is slightly different than the graph presented in the Education Key Findings summary report. Forty-six child cares that had missing values for the number of spaces now have their values filled in. Thus, the graph presented here contains the most current information about child care spaces. As reported in the Education Key Findings summary report, child care spaces are not related to SES for Winnipeg NCs, and here we see that trend is repeated for the other regions as well.

### Rate of Licensed Child Care Spaces for Children 0-12 Years of Age by Manitoba RHA, 2000

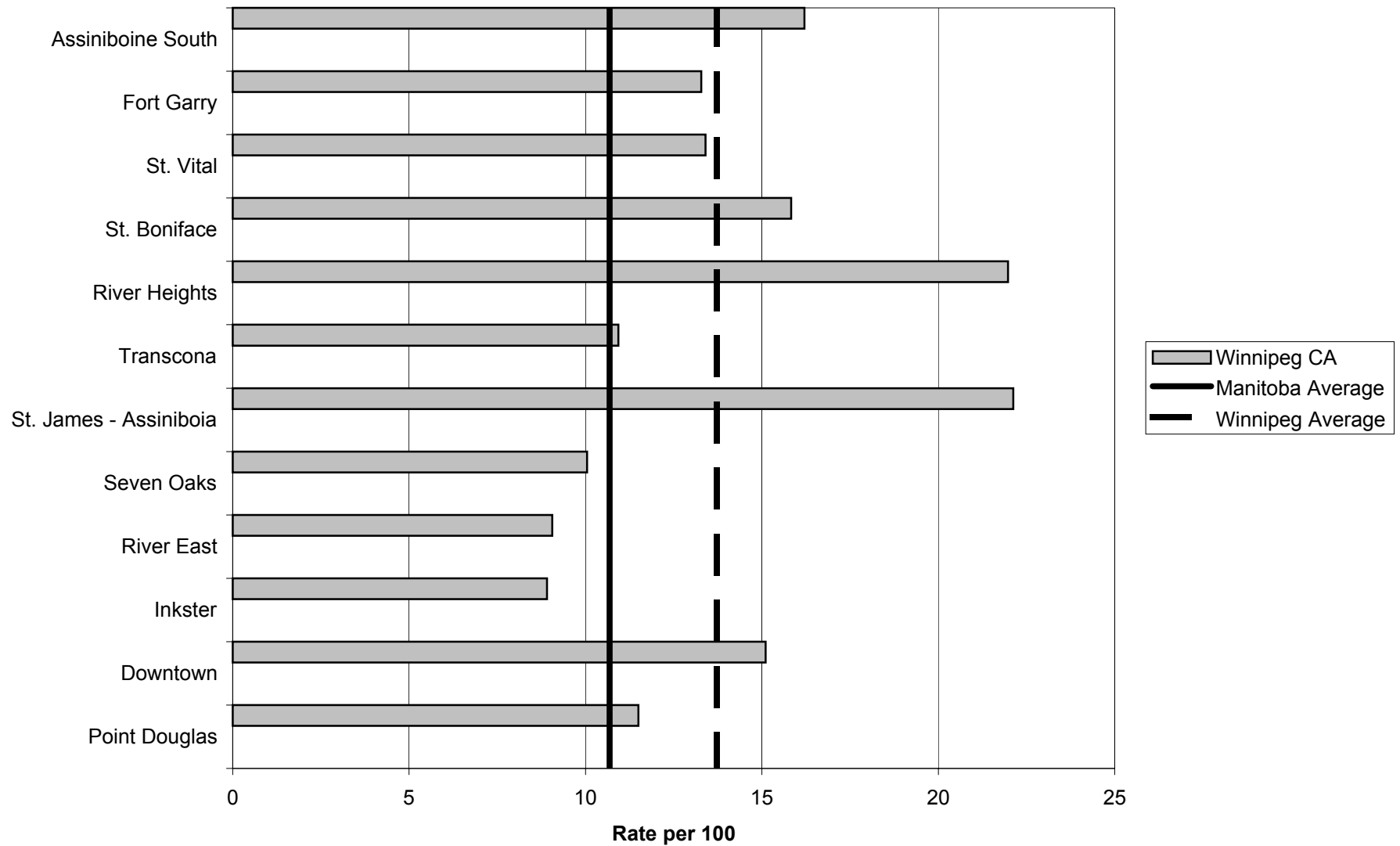


**Rate of Licensed Child Care Spaces for Children 0-12 Years of Age by RHA District, 2000**

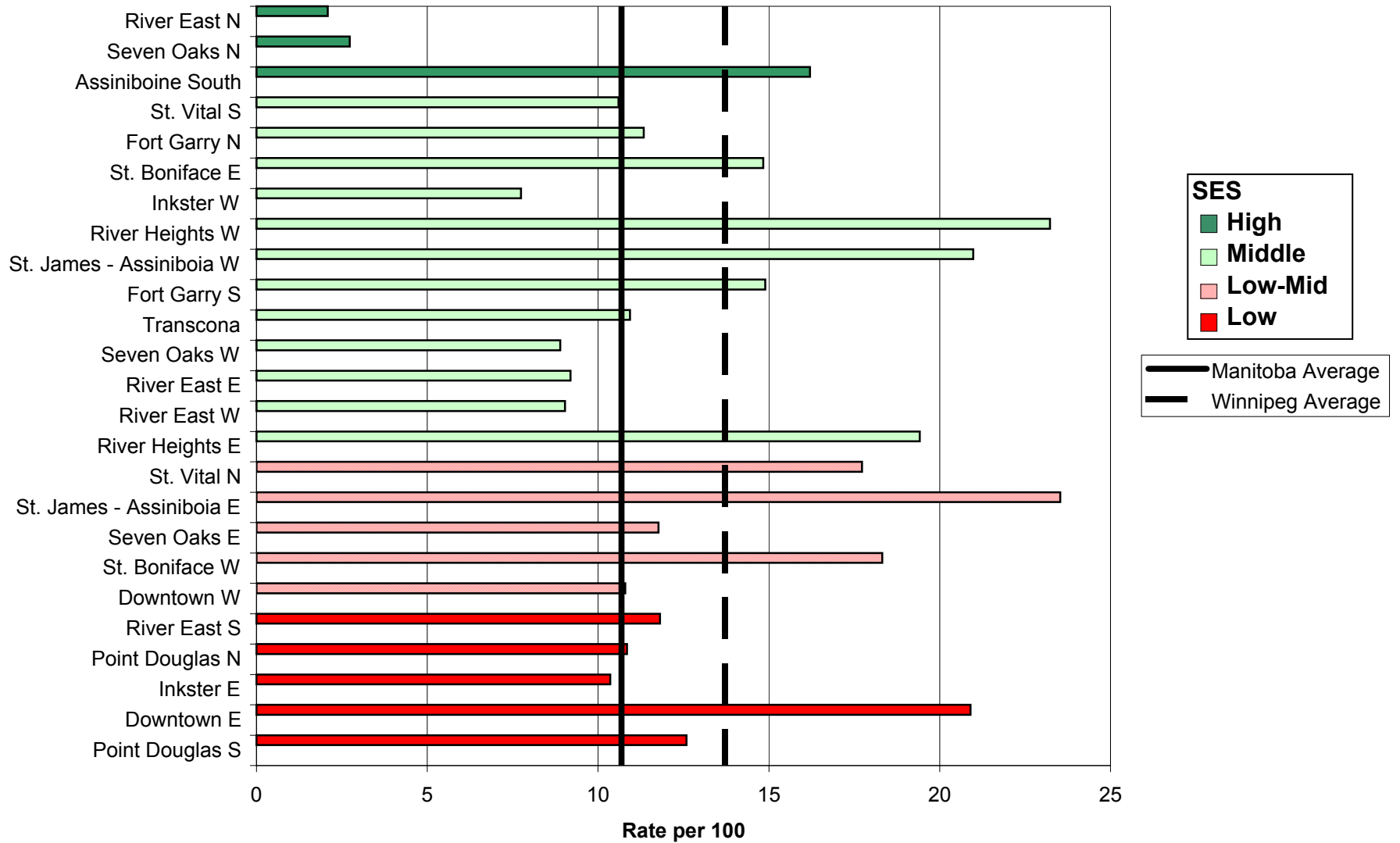


'd' indicates RHA Districts with no provincially licensed child care spaces.
