

Community Resource Indicators: Library "Winter Story Time" Attendance by Winnipeg NC

The graph presented here shows data for Winter Story Time programs held during the year 2000 at Winnipeg Public Libraries. The data are presented according to where the children attended the program, not where the children lived. Thus, in general, we see there is a high rate of attendance by children aged 3-5 years at these programs, but we cannot be sure that the children attending the programs live in the NC where they are offered. For example, the low rate of attendance in Downtown West and the high rate of attendance in Downtown East may be partly due to children living in Downtown West attending the Centennial Library program rather than the program at the West End Library. Further, we cannot tell whether the same children attended more than one Winter Story Time program.
