

Community Resource Indicators: Rate of Programs for Children Aged 0-17 Years, by Winnipeg NC

This graph shows the rate of programs offered for children aged 0-17 years. Variation is evident across the neighbourhoods, but it does not appear to be related to neighbourhood SES. Thus, the same number of programs are offered per child in high SES as well as low SES areas.
