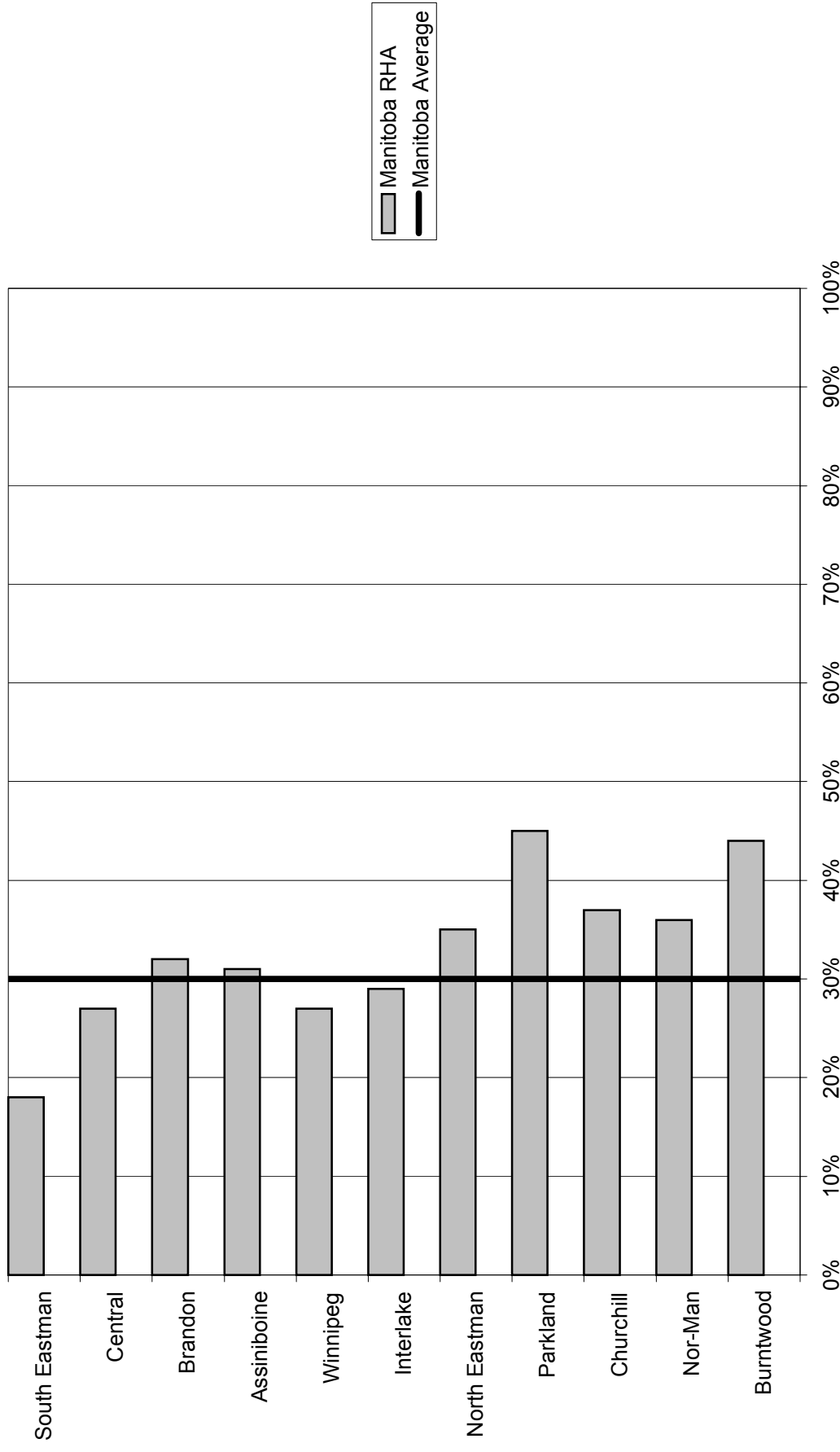

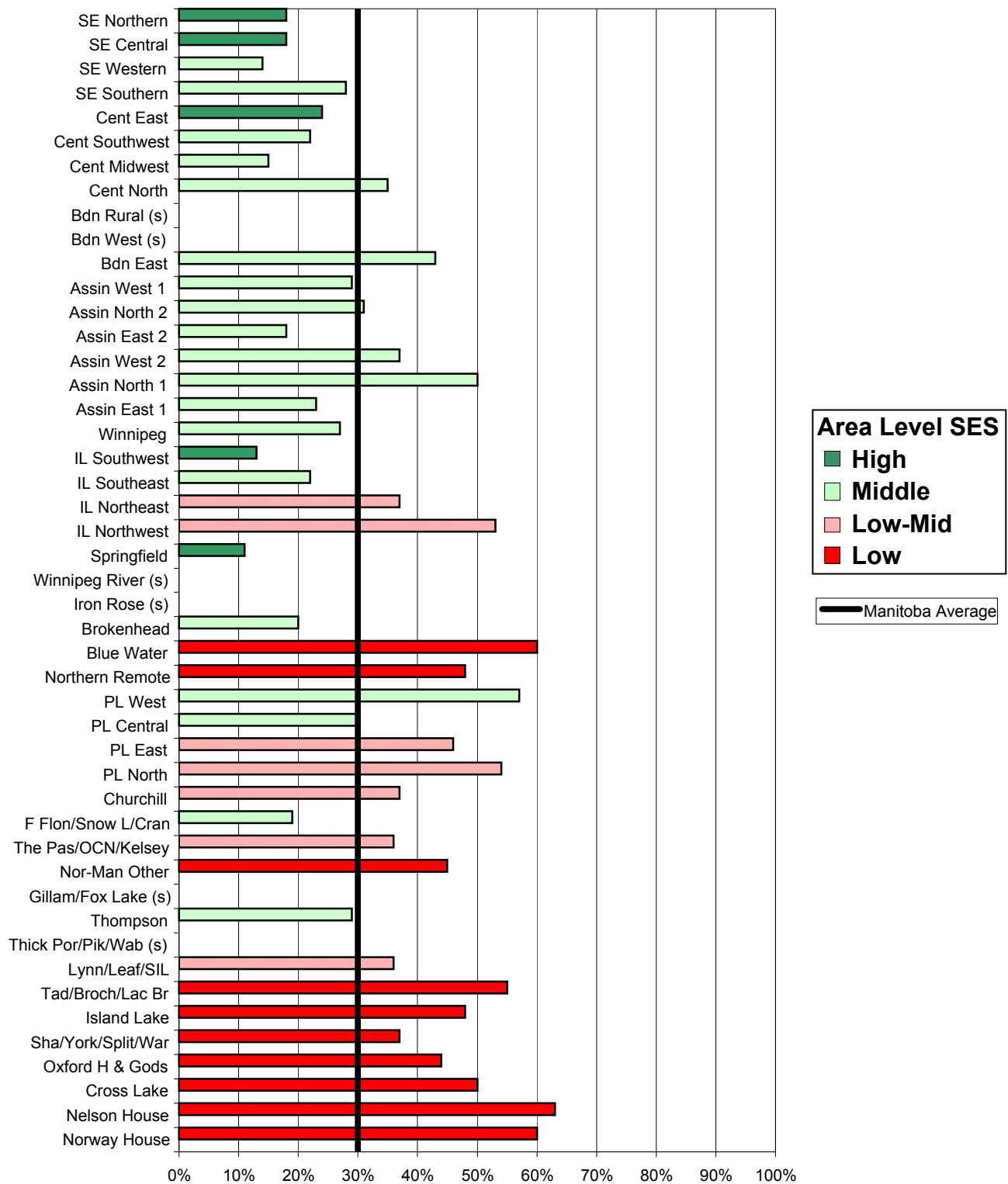
Healthy Child Indicators: Percent of Women Giving Birth who Received Healthy Baby Income Supplement During Pregnancy, by Region

The graphs presented here show the percent of women giving birth who received the Healthy Baby income supplement during pregnancy in 2002/03. Not surprisingly, given that the benefit is provided based on income, regions and neighbourhoods with the lowest SES (near the bottom of the graphs), have the highest percent of women receiving the benefit. It is important to note that almost all districts and neighbourhoods have at least some women requiring this benefit.

Percent of Women Giving Birth who Received Healthy Baby Income Supplement During Pregnancy, by Manitoba RHA, 2002/03

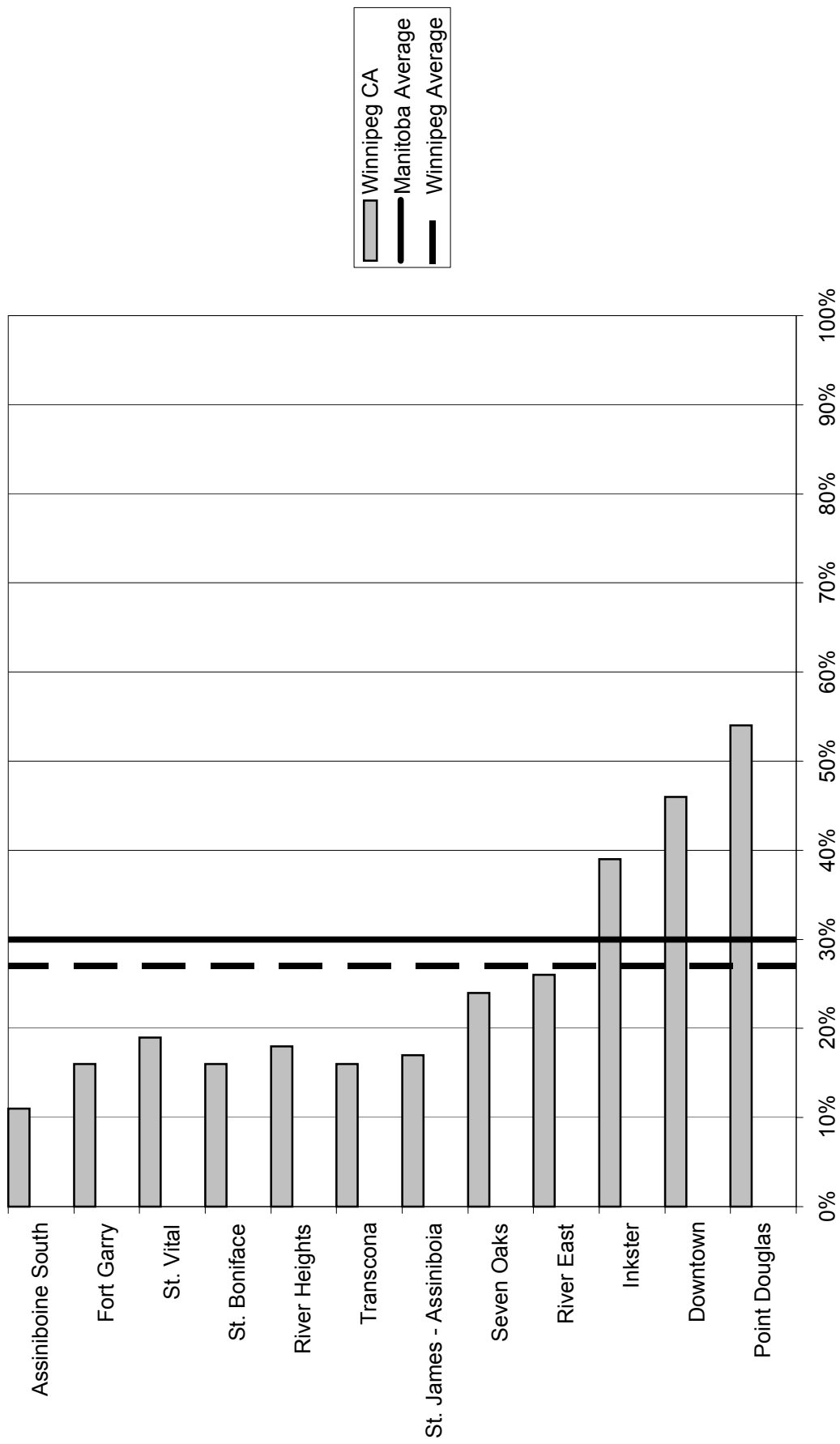


Percent of Women Giving Birth who Received Healthy Baby Income Supplement During Pregnancy, by RHA District, 2002/03

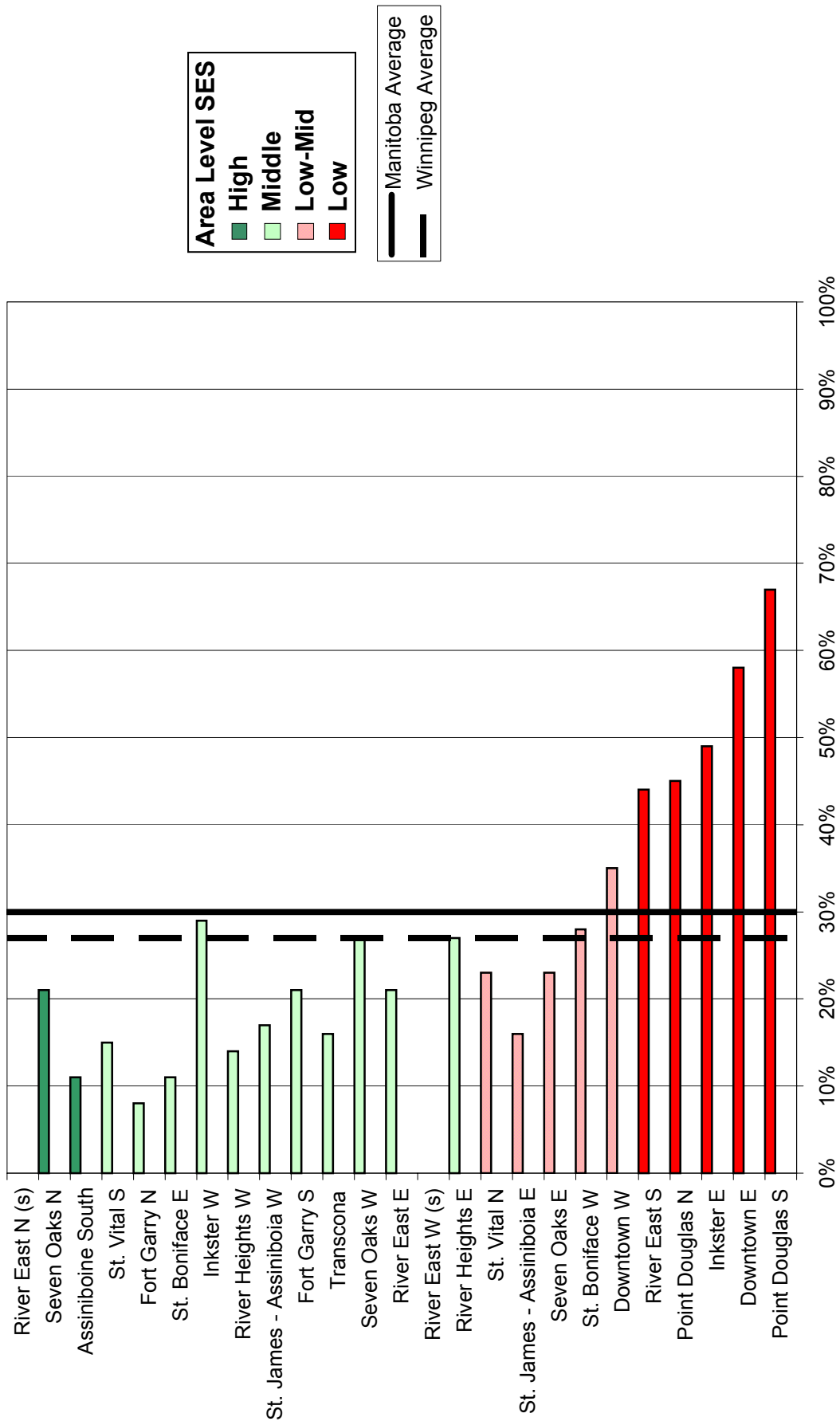
