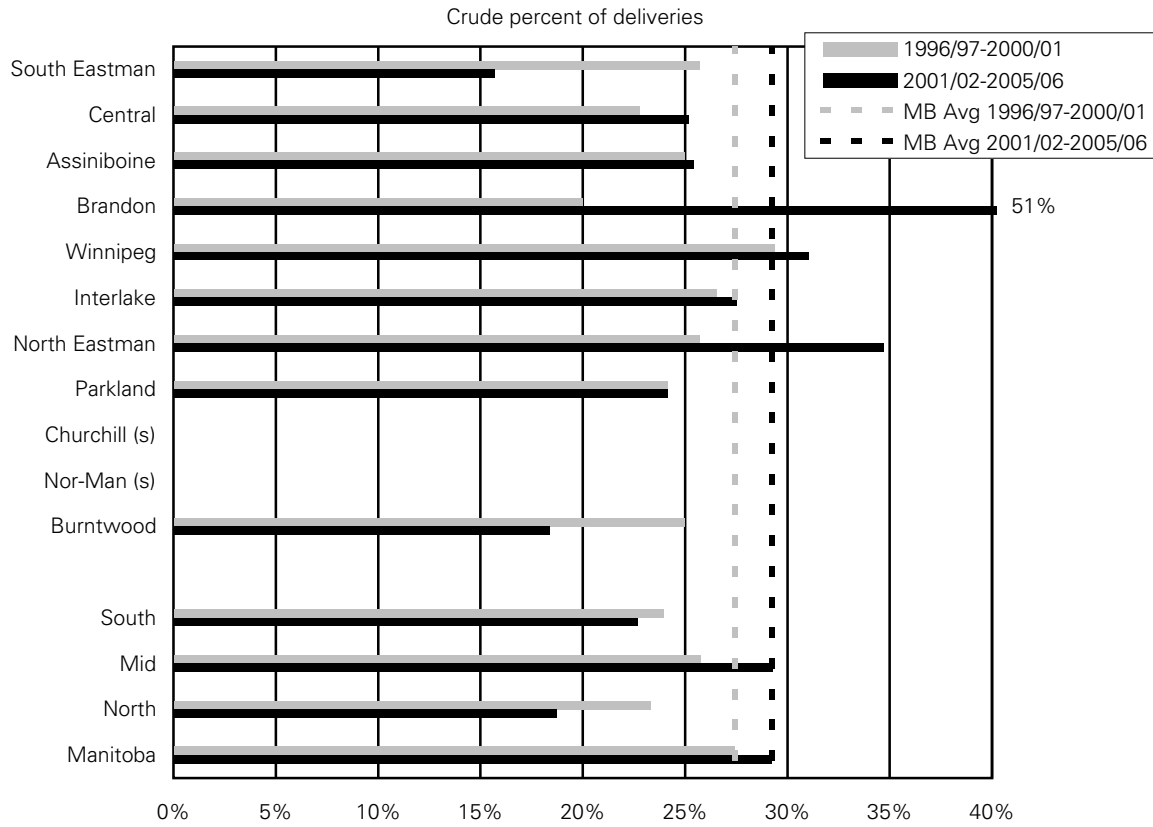


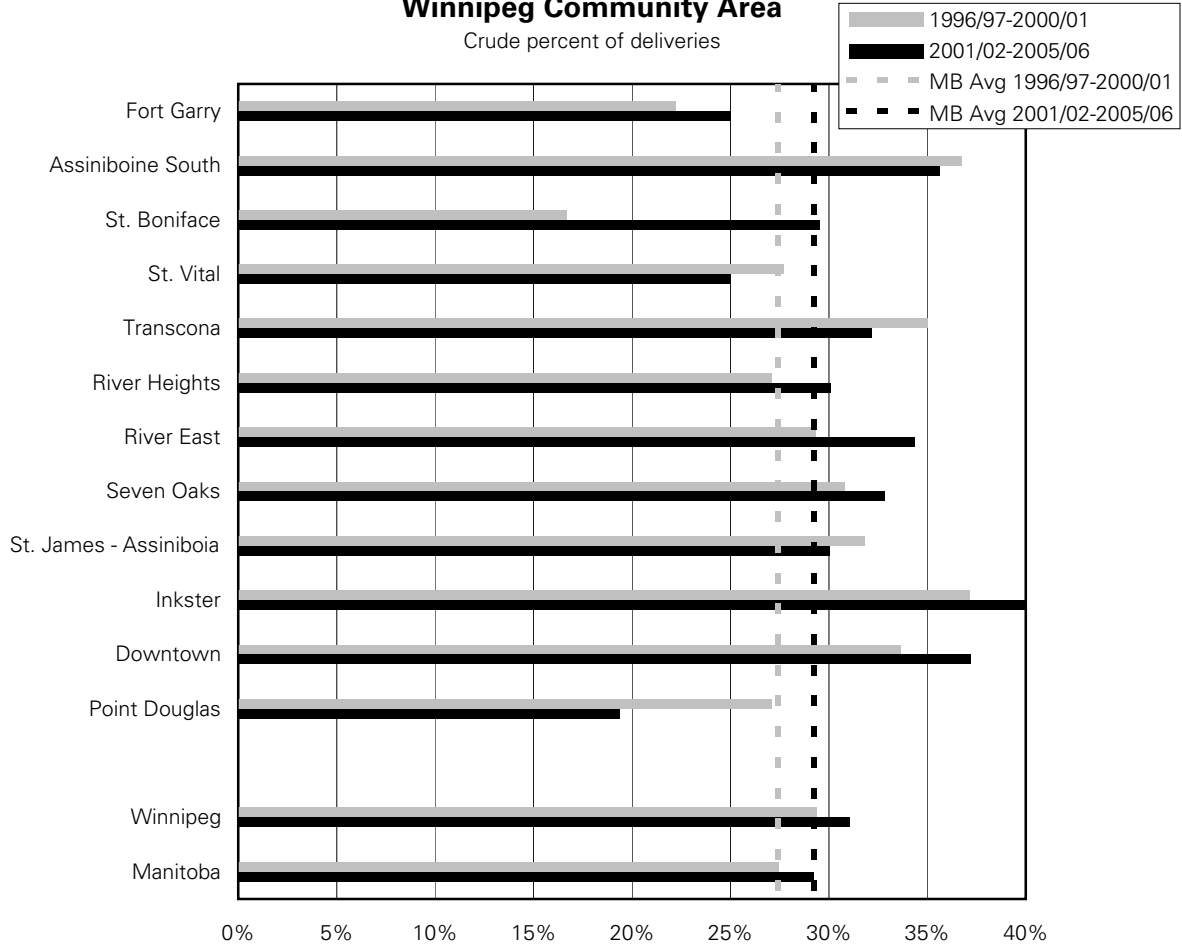
Figure A.3.34: Caesarean Section Rate of Women Aged 40 and Older by RHA
