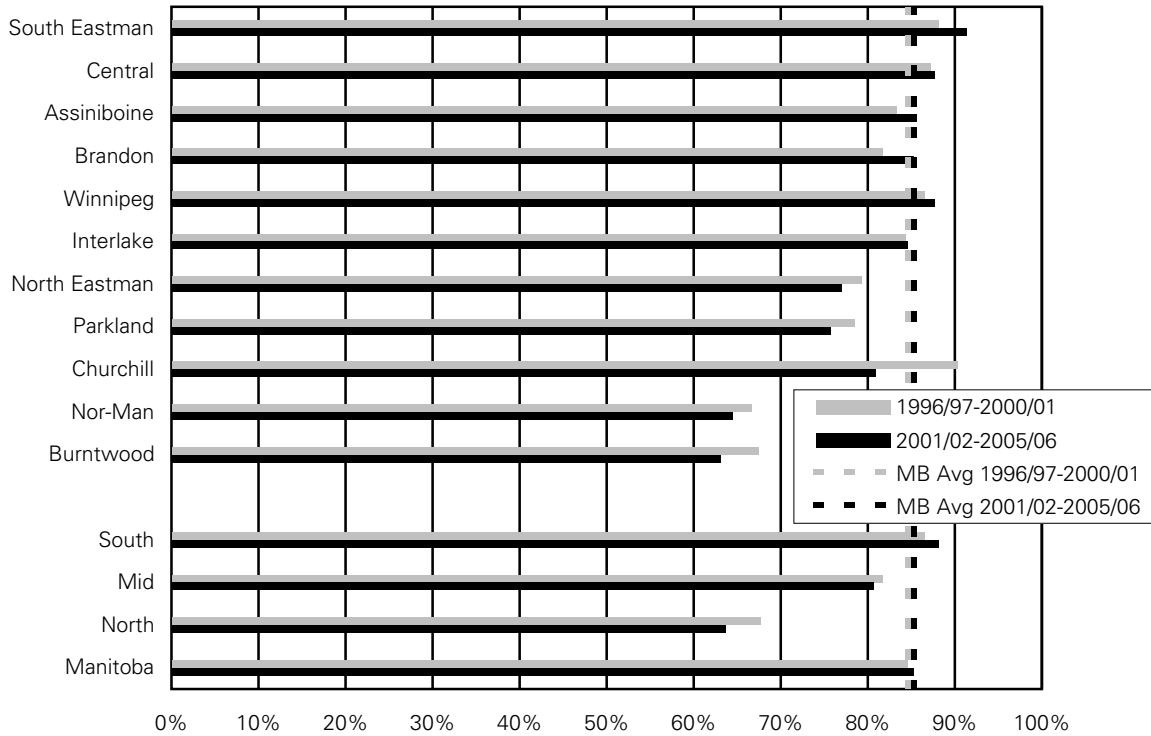


**Figure A.3.64: Breastfeeding Initiation Rates for Ages 30+ Years by RHA**

'2' indicates area's rate was statistically different from Manitoba average in second time period

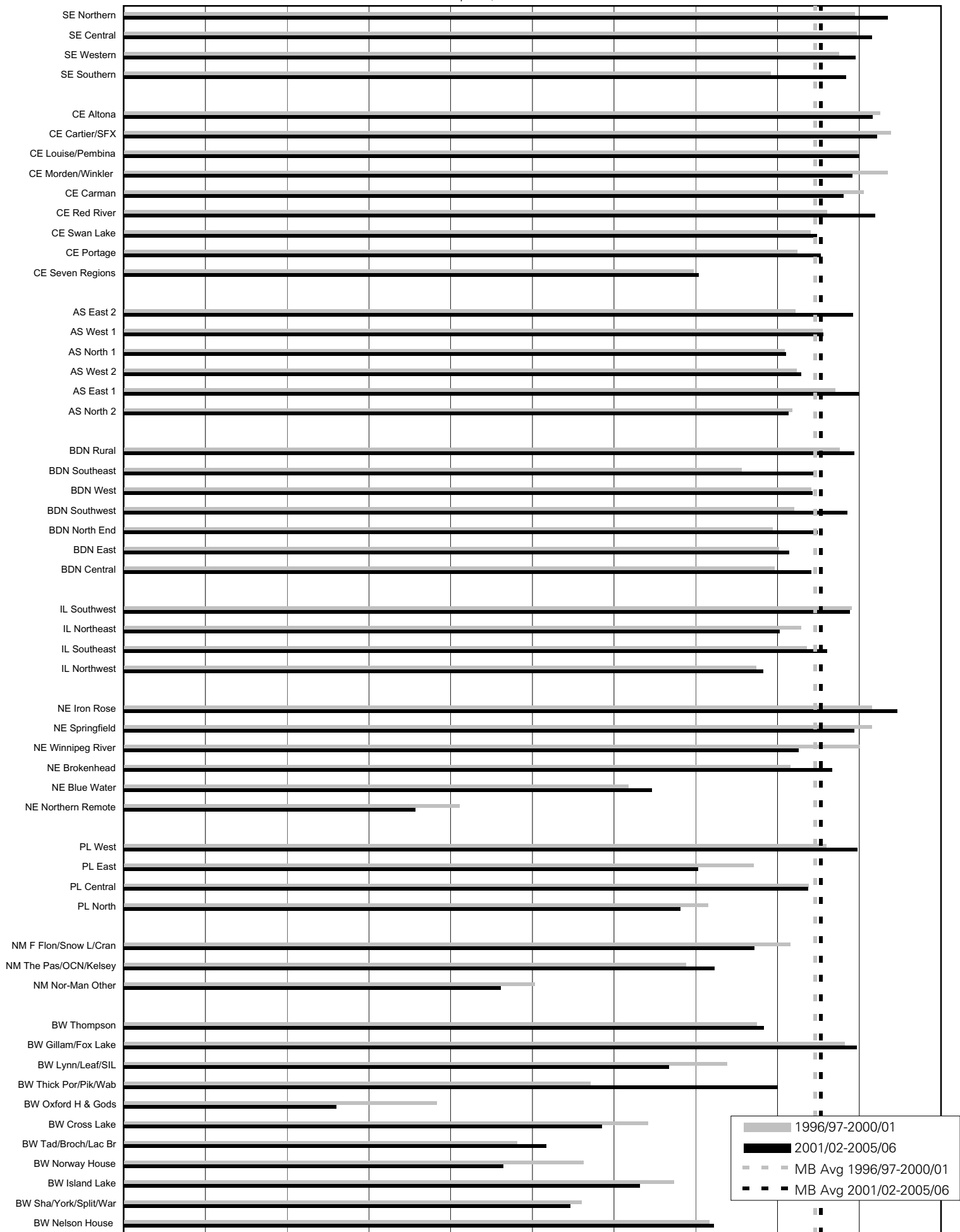
't' indicates change over time was statistically significant for that area

# Figure A.3.65: Breastfeeding Initiation Rates for Ages 30+ Years by District

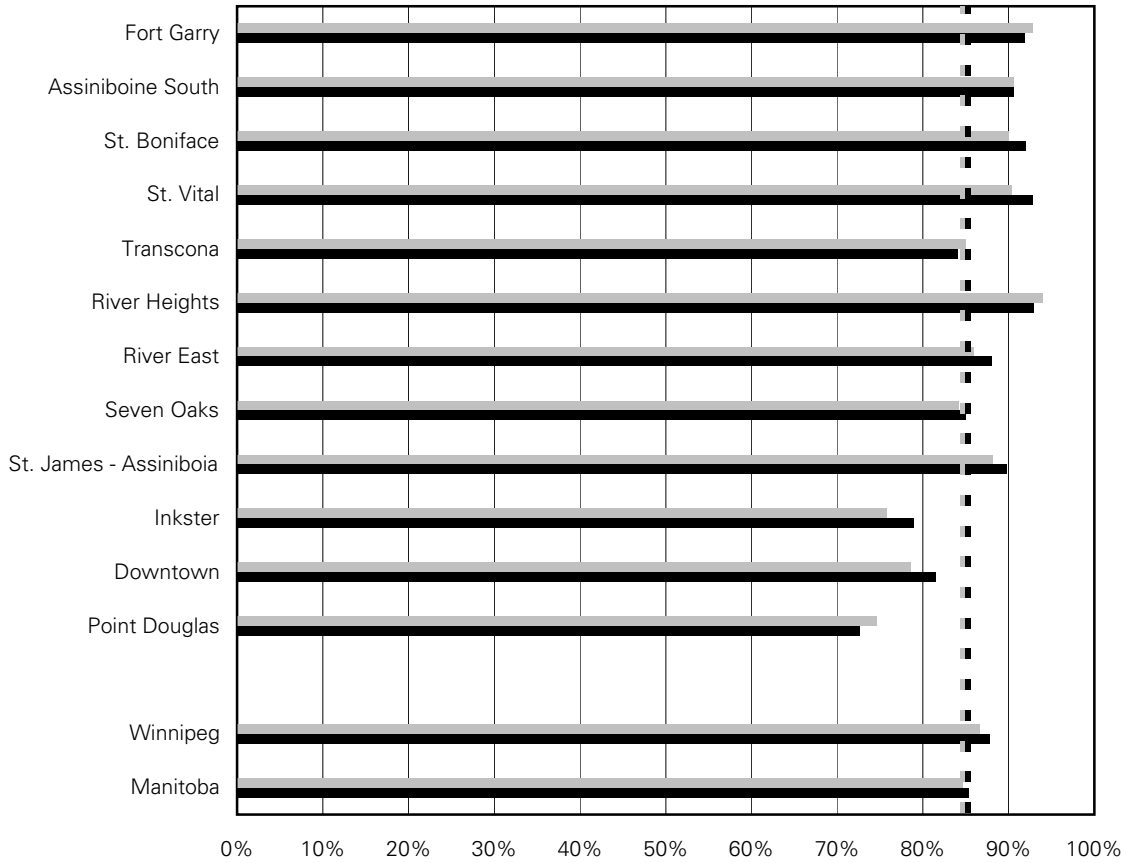
Crude rates per 1,000 women

Crude rates per 1,000 women



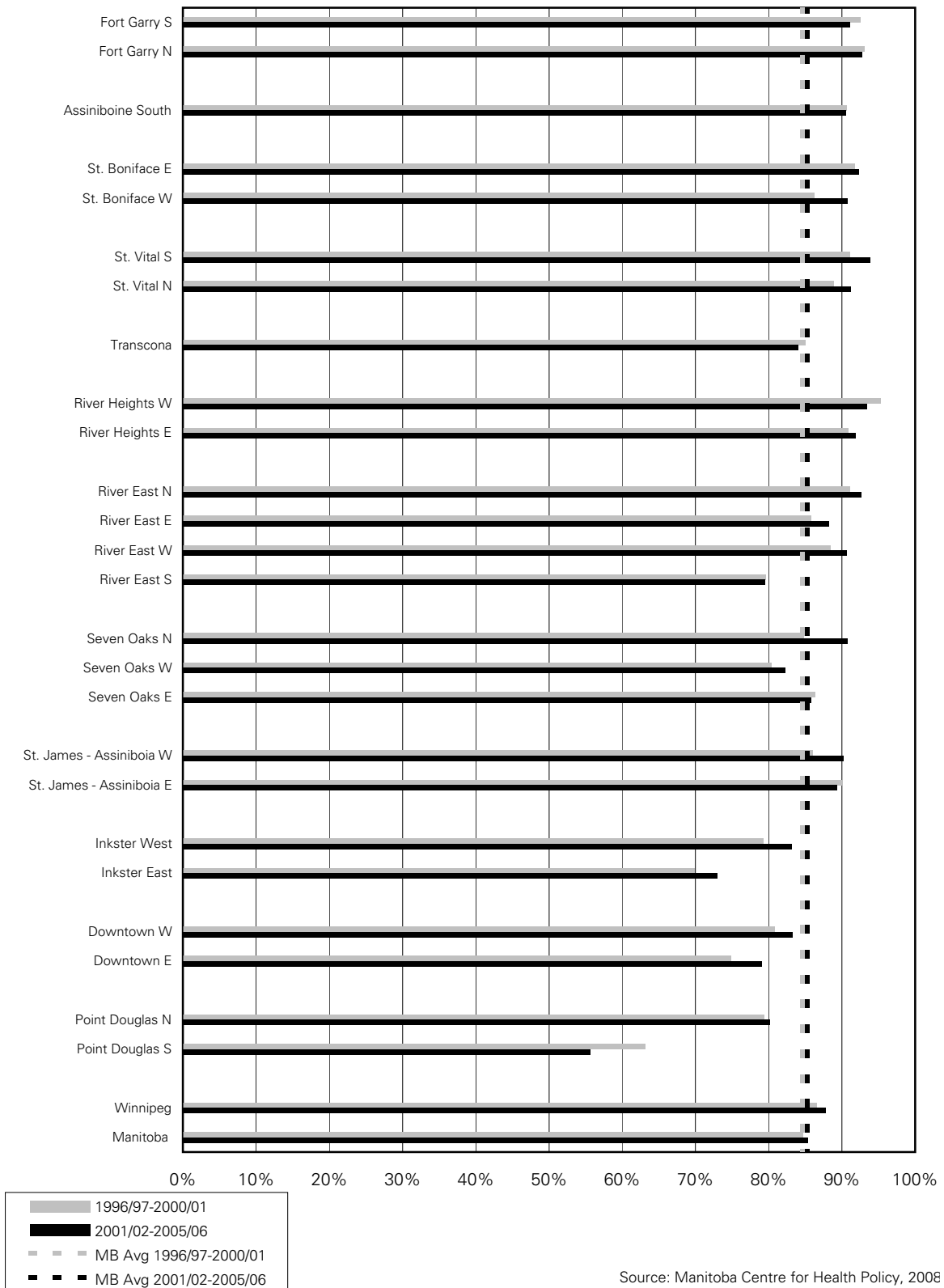

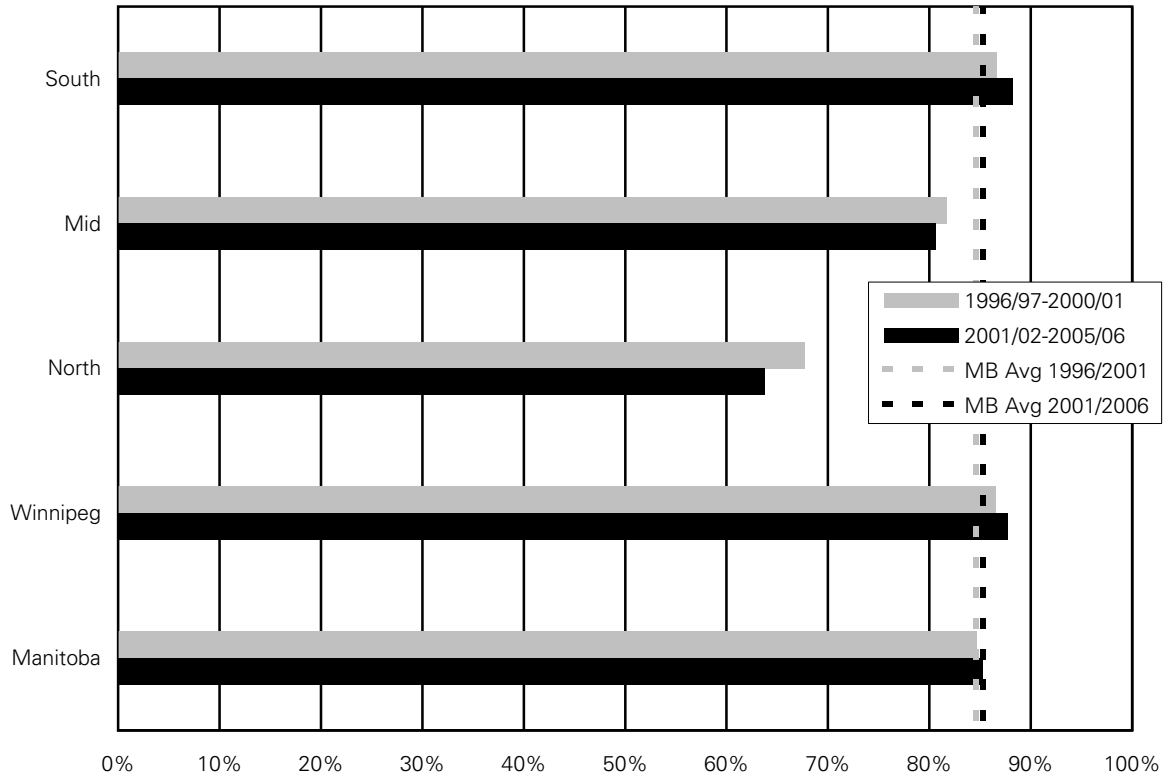
